Class Notes: Students must complete the online portion of the course prior to attending the field day. The online course is accessed by links at <http://ksoutdoors.com/Services/Education/Hunter/Internet-assisted-Course> . Each student will be issued a pre-test over the online materials.

All students will be tested over the Internet course material. This pre-test will be administered at the beginning of the Field Day. A passing score of 22 correct answers out of 25 questions is required to proceed with the rest of the course. Students failing to achieve the minimum score of 22 will be dismissed from the class.

The field walk session will be as much like an actual hunt as possible. It is recommended to wear boots or walking shoes and long pants.
