

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals for 2010 Main Street Mill and Overlay will be received at the Office of the City Clerk in Cherryvale, Kansas, at 123 Main Street, Cherryvale, Kansas, 67335 until July 26, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. local time. At which time all sealed bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Any bid received after the designated closing time will be returned unopened.

All proposals shall be submitted in sealed envelopes addressed to City of Cherryvale, Kansas, at the Office of the City Clerk, 123 Main Street, Cherryvale, Kansas, 67335, and marked "Proposal for: Bid for 2010 Main Street Mill and Overlay, City of Cherryvale". Plans, specifications, bid documents and other contract documents are on file at the office of TranSystems Corporation, 115 South Sixth Street, Suite D, Independence, Kansas 67301. Copies of bid documents may be obtained from the TranSystems Corporation office upon payment of a non-refundable deposit of Forty-Five dollars (\$45.00)

The project consists of the following:

17, 500 Sq Yds Milling 1 ½"
1,500 ton Bituminous Paving
9,000 Lineal Feet Epoxy Traffic Paint

The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids and to waive any technicalities or irregularities therein. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days from the date set for opening thereof.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a cashier's check, certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Cherryvale, Kansas, in the amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid.

Nonresident contractors or nonresident subcontractors desiring to engage in, prosecute, follow, or carry on the business of contracting in the State of Kansas shall register with the Director of Revenue for each contract where the total contract price or compensation received amounts to more than one thousand dollars, (\$1,000.00). Provided, a foreign corporation authorized to do business in this state shall not be required to register.

Each contractor or subcontractor required to register any contract shall before entering the performance of such contract, execute and file with the Director of Taxation, a good and valid bond in surety company authorized to do business in Kansas, of with sufficient sureties to be approved by the Director of Taxation. The bond must be filed before beginning any contract in the State of Kansas.

Bidders on this work, including sub-contractors or vendors, will be required to comply with the Kansas Act Against Discrimination (K.S.A. 44-1001 et. seq.) and the Kansas Age Discrimination in Employment Act (K.S.A. 44-1111 et. seq.).

Section 109 of the 1074 Housing and Community Development Act, the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Executive Order 11246 are applicable to this project. This project will also be covered by the Davis-Bacon Act, the Copeland Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and other applicable requirements as included in the Contract Document.

This project is partially funded by a Community Development Block Grant through the Kansas Department of Commerce. Minority (MBE) and Disadvantaged (DBE) Business Enterprises are encouraged to apply.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder and the Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularity in the bids and in the bidding.
